Presentations on the Rich History of the City of Wetzlar

The Wetzlar Stadtmuseum opened in 1925 in the two main buildings of the former headquarters of the Wetzlar branch of the Teutonic Order: the hostel and the tithe barn.

The permanent exhibition on the history of the city of Wetzlar is housed in the hostel building and on the ground floor of the tithe barn. A representative selection of archaeological exhibits shows the importance of the region since prehistorical times and in ancient history. In currently six rooms, the "Early Municipal History" section documents the history of Wetzlar up to the 19th century by way of selected exhibits. The tithe barn building serves as forum for the highly varied special exhibitions on topics in municipal, cultural and literary history.
